Duties:

- Ability to crowd control
- Ability to discuss wine, our menu, and our offerings to customers
- Ability to discuss our process and communicate under busy and loud conditions
- Use point of sale system

Be knowledgeable about COVID and safety related special requirements:

- Understand all Michigan government requirements for safe work ongoing basis
- Signing in daily reporting health status /COVID exposure risk
- Monitoring customer behavior including but not limited to ensuring 6' distancing, wearing of masks, controlling crowd flow at our entrance and controlling building capacity overall

Required Physical Capabilities:

- Wearing mask correctly and continually inside/outside for entire shift
- Sitting at greeting station
- Escorting customers as needed to table

Skills & Knowledge:

- Prior wine or restaurant reception experience a plus
- Attention to detail and safety is mandatory
- Patience and customer-oriented approach is mandatory
- Excellent people and communication skills with a friendly attitude is mandatory

COVID pandemic considerations:
